

The project "A Europe of Three Dimensions of the Culture of the Future: Citizen—Innovation-Technology" was financed by the European Union as part of the Europe for Citizens Programme.

Meetings of the Residents of Twinned Towns

Participants:

The project enabled 203 citizens to meet. These included 85 people from the town of Tuchów (Poland), 17 people from Tautii Magheraus (Hungary), 10 from Mikulov (the Czech Republic), 9 from Saint Jean de Braye (France), 8 from Pettenbach (Austria), 8 from Illingen (Germany), 31 from Detva (Slovakia) and 35 people from Martfu

(Hungary).

Venue/Dates: The meeting took place in Tuchów (Poland) from 20 September 2013 to 23 September 2013.

Short description:

Day 1: 20 September 2013

- a welcome, taking the participants to their places of accommodation
- presentation of the programme of the event,
- an organisational meeting with group managers and interpreters,
- The meeting with the different groups included a seminar on the directions in cultural development, called "Vectors of Contemporary Culture".

Day 2: 21 September 2013

- a study visit and sightseeing: The Cellars of the Main Square in Kraków and the Historical Museum of the City of
- Learning about the history of the old city of Kraków and about the use of new, innovative technologies in the presentation of museum exhibits and collections.
- Presentations of new technologies in the culture of the future, based on the examples of digital and 3D equipment installed in the cinema in the town of Tuchów, and learning about how cultural presentations can be enriched by means of LED screens.
- A concert at the Community Centre and an amphitheatre with performance of artistic groups.

Day 3: 22 September 2013

- A conference called "Open Citizens of Dialogue" at the Tuchów Municipal Museum,
- international artistic performances called Tradition for the Future (artistic performances accompanied by a parade of fire-fighters based in Tuchów, other towns in the district of Tarnów, twinned towns, and by celebrations of the 130th anniversary of the Voluntary Fire Service of Tuchów). The artistic performances were given by dance groups from Tuchów and the twinned towns and included contemporary dance, modern dance, musical and vocal performances in modern versions with the use of digital equipment and a LED screen. The performances were accompanied by presentations of new, innovative display and exhibition technologies.
- presentations of projects as part of EU programmes for the Małopolskie province.
- an exhibition in Tuchów Town Square, accompanied by the Małopolska European Picnic.

Day 3 23 September 2013

- a summary meeting on the directions for cultural development and future work during the 2014-2020 financial perspective. A farewell meeting and departure of the participants. **GMINA TUCHÓW**
